Spaying and neutering pets is vital to ending pet overpopulation in our community.

Unwanted pets resulting from unplanned pregnancies often end up in the shelter and face the possibility of euthanization or live a dangerous life on the streets where disease and early death is common.

Consider these sobering statistics:

- One female cat and her offspring can theoretically produce 420,000 cats in seven years
- One female dog and her offspring can theoretically produce 67,000 dogs in six years
- The average cost of spaying or neutering a pet is less than the cost of raising a litter of puppies or kittens
- On average, it costs U.S. taxpayers approximately \$100 to capture, house, feed, and eventually euthanize every homeless animal.
